At the meeting of the Police Commission on Wednesday, November 5, 2025, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 25-85

APPROVAL TO FORWARD COMMISSION REQUESTED SFPD DISTRICT BOUNDARY ANALYSIS TO ADJUST STATION BOUNDARIES TO THE MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS;

BACKGROUND

Background: The SFPD must submit a police district boundary analysis once every 10 years, after the results of the federal decennial census.

An exhaustive analysis was completed in 2024 (link: <u>San Francisco Police Boundary Analysis 2024</u>) and provided to the Police Commission at the end of 2024, which posted publicly in February 2025 (link: <u>February 19, 2025 Police Commission meeting | SF.gov</u>).

In June of 2025, the commission requested the SFPD conduct additional analysis on recommendations made by the public. Initial analysis was presented to the Police Commission in July. (link: <u>July 16, 2025 Police Commission meeting | SF.gov</u>)






