**RESCISSION OF ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE CITY
AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO REQUIRING HOSPITALS IN THE
CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO PROVIDE PATIENT
DATA FOR INPATIENTS WITH SARS-COV-2 INFECTIONS FOR THE
PURPOSE OF PUBLIC HEALTH PREVENTION AND RESPONSE
EFFORTS**

(PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY ORDER)

DATE OF RESCISSION: January 9, 2026

The Health Officer of the City and County of San Francisco (the “Health Officer”) previously issued an order establishing a system for the daily transfer of patient-specific information into the San Francisco Department of Public Health’s confidential COVID-19 Hospital Data Repository System for all COVID-19 and SARS-CoV-2 inpatients. That order, Health Officer Order No. C19-16, was issued on December 11, 2020. By this rescission order, the Health Officer hereby rescinds Order No. C19-16 in full, effective immediately upon issuance of this Rescission.
