On January 26, 2026, the Small Business Commission (the Commission) heard BOS File No. 251251 – Tenderloin and South of Market Retail Hours Restriction Pilot Program. Bryan Dahl, Legislative Aide for Supervisor Dorsey, presented the legislation, which would expand the current Tenderloin retail hours restriction pilot program to include the South of Market neighborhood and extend the duration of the pilot timeline.

The Commission discussed their previous work in identifying economic mitigation measures in support of small businesses that were adversely affected by City-mandated tobacco control laws. The Commission acknowledged that many of those operators will be impacted by this proposal. A majority of the Commission voted to oppose this legislation.
