# First Public Health Center in San Francisco

The San Francisco Department of Public Health's Castro-Mission Health Center (CMHC) proudly serves all San Franciscans, from new immigrants to life-long residents, with a special commitment to uninsured, low-income, and medically underserved persons.

Established in 1965 steps away from the heart of the historic Castro District, the health center was the first public health center to open in San Francisco and one of the first clinics to offer treatment for HIV/AIDS.

As one of the San Francisco Health Network's 14 neighborhood clinics, Castro-Mission Health Center's dedicated medical team provides a full range of primary care for adults, children and pregnant people. Services include treating common health concerns, preventative medicine, and management of chronic illnesses such as high blood pressure and diabetes. The whole health approach allows patients to be seen by multiple health care providers in one visit.

The health center is also home to Gender Health SF, a specialty clinic for LGBTQ+ patients to access gender affirming care.


