Dear Commissioners,
My name is Lisa King. I am a 36 year resident of San Francisco and member of Showing Up For Racial Justice San Francisco Chapter.

I'm writing because I'm deeply concerned about the March 22 video from SFO showing SFPD officers blocking community members from filming or interacting with unbadged supposed ICE agents who tackled and detained a woman while her child watched in distress. Videos showed SFPD officers apparently forming a wall to shield the ICE agents from public attention. This undermines San Francisco's sanctuary city laws and our community's trust.

Please count this as a complaint that your constituents (here's to hoping you read this as residents of and visitors to San Francisco) will need your position on this matter to be public and will also be voiced to the Board of Supervisors, the Police Chief's office, Department of Police Accountability, and with the Mayor's Office. Sanctuary here will not be infringed.

SFPD will uphold human rights and our laws in the city of St. Francis.
