# 1. Call Meeting to Order

Meeting was called to order by Member Neary at 5:03pm

### 2. Ramaytush Ohlone Land Acknowledgement

We acknowledge that we are on the unceded ancestral homeland of the Ramaytush (rah-my-toosh) Ohlone (O-lon-ee) who are the original inhabitants of the San Francisco Peninsula. As the Indigenous stewards of this land, and in accordance with their traditions, the Ramaytush Ohlone have never ceded, lost, nor forgotten their responsibilities as the caretakers of this place, as well as for all peoples who reside in their traditional territory. As guests, we recognize that we benefit from living and working on their traditional homeland. We wish to pay our respects by acknowledging the Ancestors, Elders, and Relatives of the Ramaytush Ohlone community and by affirming their sovereign rights as First Peoples.

# 8. Virtual Meetings During Public Health Emergency

For Action: Resolution to allow teleconferenced meetings under California Government Code Section 54953(e)

The HCH Co-Applicant Board will consider resolution which would give it, and all of its subcommittees, authority to meet remotely for the next 30 days.

- Virginia Dario Elizondo from the Office of the City Attorney introduced above item to allow meetings to be held virtually and not in-person during the pandemic
- A vote was held to support the meeting being held virtually. See Roll Call and Voting Record table on last two pages of these minutes for details.

#### 9. General Public Comment

Each member of the public may address the HCH CAB for up to two minutes. The Brown Act forbids a commission from taking action or discussing any item not appearing on the posted agenda, including those items raised at public comment. # 10. Review, Discuss, and Approve Co-Applicant Board Bylaws

- Member Neary walked through key elements of the Co-Applicant Board Bylaws full document with the group
- Member Discipola asked for a bit more information on what Sliding Fee Scale and some of the financial items listed in the Bylaws entailed
- Member Neary responded that the Sliding Fee Scale is the per visit cost an uninsured patient may be charged for a visit at one of the health centers. The SFDPH sliding fee scale charged per visit rates between \$0 and \$10, and does not limit service delivery for those who are unable to pay or have a prior unpaid fee. There will be a fuller presentation of the San Francisco Health Network (SFHN) Sliding Fee Scale at some point this year, and every year thereafter, to the HCH CAB.
- Member Discipola asked about the topics and goals the federal grant funder has for the HCH CAB's oversight and how that will translate into the HCH CAB meeting topics

- Member Neary responded that there is a fairly robust set of topics the federal grantor asks that the program bring to the HCH CAB meetings, and that SFDPH will follow the HCH CAB's lead on how much time those presentations or materials will take up on HCH CAB meeting agendas
- Member Discipola recommended that SFDPH may want to share more with the HCH CAB at some point soon about the goals and priorities of the federal funder and our local HCH program
- HCH CAB decided to take break before vote was held to allow time for additional questions to be raised

# Review, Discuss, and Approve Co-Applicant Board Bylaws (Continued)

- Member Discepola moved to approve, and Member Jordan seconded
- Bylaws were adopted by a unanimous vote of the 8 members present at the time of the roll call vote. Full vote record available on last two pages of these minutes

# 12. Review, Discuss, and Approve Co-Applicant Board Agreement

- Member Neary walked through key elements of the Co-Applicant Board Agreement full document with the group, with an emphasis on the SFDPH side of the agreement since the HCH CAB side is substantially similar to what had just been reviewed in the HCH CAB Bylaws
- Member Pounders moved to approve, and Member Jordan seconded
- SFDPH-HCH CAB Agreement was adopted by a unanimous vote of the 9 members present at the time of the roll call vote. Full vote record available on last two pages of these minutes.

# 13. Co-Applicant Board Chair Nomination(s) and Election

- Member Neary provided a brief verbal review of the three HCH CAB leadership roles that were open for election at the meeting, in light of the Bylaws having been adopted earlier in the meeting
- Member Pounders recommended that we check in with the group as a whole first about who may be interested in stepping up to fill any of the three leadership roles

- Each group member was surveyed individually for their interest and comfort level in a potential Chair, Vice-Chair, or Secretary role
- Member Telusca was the sole member who expressed potential interest in the role of HCH CAB Chair
- Member Jordan was the sole member who expressed potential interest in the role of HCH CAB Secretary
- No members expressed interest in the HCH Vice-Chair role in the initial survey, and it was planned to re-visit that election at a future meeting
- Member Discepola nominated Member Telusca to be the new HCH CAB Chair, and Member Pounders seconded
- Member Telusca was elected as HCH Board Chair by a unanimous vote of the 9 members present

# 14. Co-Applicant Board Vice-Chair Nomination(s) and Election

- Member Sullivan moved to postpone the Vice-Chair election to a later meeting, and Member Discepola seconded
- Motion to postpone Vice-Chair election was adopted by consent of 9 members present

# 15. Co-Applicant Board Secretary Nomination(s) and Election

- Member Sullivan nominated Member Jordan to be the new HCH CAB Secretary, and Member Penagos seconded
- Member Jordan was elected as HCH Board Secretary by a unanimous vote of the 9 members present

# 16. Discuss and Schedule 2022 Meeting Dates and Times

Note 1: The length of the meeting will be determined by the HCH Co-Applicant Board and does not need to be two hours.

Note 2: Meetings will be held in person when the declared state of emergency has passed, or earlier if this Co-Applicant Board votes to meet in person sooner.

Note 3: Tuesday evenings also potentially work well for HCH Co-Applicant Board Member schedules if an alternate day of the week is needed.

# 17. Discussion of In Person and Virtual Meeting Preferences

- The HCH CAB Members were asked to share their thoughts and comfort level of possibly moving to in person meetings or staying with virtual meetings for the short term while still under a public health emergency order
- The full Membership were surveyed, replying individually about their comfort and concerns
- As this was not a noticed vote item, no consensus was sought, and the input ranged from 4 people with a preference for or no objection to in person, 2 people either open to or with a preference for in person though noted that the above meeting times may need to be revisited to allow travel time, 2 people with a preference for virtual based on health and safety concerns, and 1 person preferring hybrid to allow for both attendance options
- This item will appear on future agendas for continued discussion and deliberation
