Know Your Rights under the Sunshine Ordinance

Government's duty is to serve the public, reaching its decisions in full view of the public. Commissions, boards, councils and other agencies of the City and County exist to conduct the people's business. The Sunshine Ordinance assures that deliberations are conducted before the people and that City operations are open to the people's review. For information on your rights under the Sunshine Ordinance (Chapter 67 of the San Francisco Administrative Code) or to report a violation of the ordinance, contact Sunshine Ordinance Task Force at 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, Room 409, by phone at (415) 554-7724, by fax at (415) 554-7854, or by email at sotf@sfgov.org. Members of the public may obtain a free copy of the Sunshine Ordinance by contacting the email noted or by printing Chapter 67 of the San Francisco Administrative Code at <https://sfgov.org/sunshine>.

The SF HCH Co-Applicant Board may convene standing committees where Co-Applicant Board business and creation of motions for the Co-Applicant Board action occur, and members of the public are welcome to attend. Co-Applicant Board procedures do not permit: 1) persons in the audience at a Co-Applicant Board meeting to vocally express support or opposition to statements by Co-Applicant Board members or by other persons testifying, outside of public comment; 2) ringing of cell phones, pagers, and similar sound-producing electronic devices; 3) signs to be brought into the meeting or displayed in the room.
