The San Francisco Department of Public Health's San Francisco City Clinic (SFCC) is a trusted source for sexual health services and has proudly served San Franciscans for more than 100 years, with a special commitment to uninsured, low-income, and medically underserved persons.

San Francisco City Clinic's mission is to improve the sexual health of San Francisco communities by preventing, diagnosing, and treating sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and HIV, and preventing unintended pregnancy.

The health center is a key part of the City's commitment to reduce HIV infections in San Francisco and is a national model in sexual health services. SFCC has contributed to critical, cutting-edge advances in the public health study of STI and HIV epidemiology, testing and treatment—by hosting national studies, including for the HIV prevention drug PrEP, bacterial infection drug Doxy-PEP, and new treatments for gonorrhea.

The dedicated clinical and public health professionals provide patients with top-quality sexual health services in a safe environment without judgment.


Services We Provide

- On-site lab results for HIV, HCV, pregnancy, gonorrhea, chlamydia & syphilis
- Pre-& post-exposure prophylaxes (PrEP & PEP) for HIV
- Doxy-PEP for STIs
- Partner services for persons with newly diagnosed Syphilis or HIV
- Immunizations (including Covid-19 & mpox)
- Reproductive health
- · Behavioral health
- OD prevention (Narcan & fentanyl test strips)

How We Make a Difference

LGBTQ Health Services

Specialized care offered to the LGBTQ communities of San Francisco with pride, respect, and confidence.

On Site Lab

Patients can walk in, get tested for infections such as syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia, HIV and Hep C, and get results and treatment the same day.

HIV Prevention & Care

Patients can receive expert HIV medical care and social work assistance, including access to PrEP treatment which reduces the risk of contracting HIV from sex by 99% when taken as prescribed.
