- CIS approval required and submitted by SFCCC on behalf of SFDPH.
- Site must be added to HRSA EHB through CIS questionnaire.
- Return to permanent site upon completion of remodel
- HCH CAB members highlighted the importance of having multiple wheelchairs available at the entrance at the hospital and ideally people will help push anyone who needs assistance on the 4th floor.
- In addition to these specific issues several CAB Members added that accessibilities for people with disabilities may meet the ADA requirements will be challenging some clients in real life. They

recommended people with disabilities to test out the new spaces before opening.

- In HCH CAB Members also mention Tom Waddell waiting room is looking very dated and likely need a fresh coat of paint and furniture to make sure patients feel uplifted and comfortable.
- A HCH CAB Member Chinatown Public run a patient survey few months in a temporary location to ask anyone about the space and flow.
