21.15(c)	 Emergency Procurements: Modifications of Existing Agreements Authorizes renegotiation of commercial terms and conditions on existing contracts to address emergencies
21.15(d)	 Emergency Procurements: Extensions for Continuity of Operations Authorizes extensions of expiring contracts when it is infeasible to re-solicit during an emergency to ensure continuity of mission-critical operations
