


About Transitional Age Youth System of Care

Our Goal: expand and provide behavioral health services for TAY* (ages 16 - 25+) in San Francisco, especially TAY at-risk of or experiencing homelessness, Black/African American TAY, LGBTQ+, Asian and Pacific Islanders, Latino & Mayan, and systems-involved TAY including foster care, juvenile/criminal justice.

*Transitional Age Youth (TAY): individuals who are navigating the complex transition from adolescence to adulthood. TAY age range can span between 16 to 29.

Transitional Age Youth System of Care Ages 16 – 25+






Current Snapshot of TAY Clients
