Scope of resource guide

As per updated safer use supply distribution policy, effective April 30, 2025:

Staff must offer treatment referrals and connections to treatment at every interaction to the extent practical and receivable by the participant. At a minimum, staff should inform every participant accessing safer use supplies that the program site is also a resource to learn more and be connected to treatment.

Scope of resource guide:

This is not an exhaustive list of services and programs available in San Francisco. This resource guide is primarily intended to cover services for people who use drugs provided by SFDPH and SFDPH-funded partners.

The referral information is provider-facing and should not be shared with clients.

Frequency of updates:

This resource guide will be published online at the sf.gov website and sent via email to providers upon request. An updated resource guide will be published once per quarter. The lower-lefthand corner indicates how recently this version has been updated.

Scope: more intensive care for people experiencing acute withdrawal from drugs or alcohol

- All sites offer: Supportive residential setting for safe withdrawal from drugs or alcohol, monitoring and support for self-administered medications
 - Usually for 4 – 7 days depending on medical necessity
- Some sites offer: Medication support, individual and group counseling

Medication for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD)

Buprenorphine

Scope: medication for opioid use disorder, prescribed for pickup at a pharmacy

- All sites offer: **Drop-in** prescription and navigation, on-site pharmacy pickup, microdosing starts, & traditional starts
- Some sites offer: Injectable buprenorphine, sending prescriptions to other local pharmacies, navigation/case management related to treatment (i.e. insurance, ID)
 - **DPH Teleמוד:** Telehealth prescribing available 16 hours/day, 7 days/week: talk to a provider about medication options

Methadone

Scope: medication for opioid use disorder, dispensed at a licensed clinic

- All sites offer: Drop-in intakes, take-home doses & therapeutic dosing earlier in treatment, counseling (individual and group)
- All sites offer: intake for clients who currently have Medi-Cal in another county, reside in SF, and plan to transfer their insurance to SF
- Some sites offer: intake by appointment, transportation support, ID/insurance support, incentivized peer referral programs
 - Bridge Clinic: Up to 3 days of dosing available while connecting to an OTP
