Accuses Prosecutor

TREASURE ISLAND, Oct. 4.— Testimony of a Negro sailor today precipitated a legal brawl that smashed Naval decorum in the crowded courtroom at the general court-martial building here.

Seaman Second Class Alphonse MacPherson testified that Lieutenant Commander Frank Coakley, judge advocate in the mutiny trial of the 50 Negro enlisted men on carges of refusing to load ammunition after the Port Chicago disaster, had resorted to intimidation and threats in an effort to build up his case against the seamen.

MacPherson said that Coakley had told him at Camp Shoemaker, where the alleged


MAP OF U.S.RECEIVING SHIP SAN I (YERBA BUENA ISLAN





SHOWING CONDITIONS C .ILINE 30 1940




