Urban Myths

URBAN MYTH: I cannot obtain medical care for my injury after I separate from the City.

URBAN FACT: You are entitled to ongoing medical care for accepted work injuries—even after you separate from City employment.

Separation means leaving City employment due to retirement, resignation, or other reasons. While Separation may impact wage-replacement benefits, it **does not affect your right to medical treatment** for approved Workers' Compensation claims.
