The San Francisco Department of Public Health's **Adult Immunization & Travel Clinic (AITC)** is a fee-for-service clinic established in 1999 that has served well over a hundred thousand patients since inception. The staff at AITC have expertise with preventive medicine prior to international travel and with all CDC-recommended immunizations including:

- Teens and adults, including seniors, seeking recommended vaccinations for personal health and protection
- Individuals and families planning international travel
- Adults who need vaccines or proof-of-immunity for work or school
- Immigrants to the US requiring vaccines for Change of Status (green card)
- Children needing vaccines required for school who don't have a pediatrician

AITC services are by appointment only in order to minimize clinic wait times.

AITC is not contracted with insurance plans and is unable to accept insurance – instead, all fees must be paid at the time of service. AITC strives to make free and low-cost vaccines available to those who qualify – please see our pricing web page for updated availability and eligibility.

Services We Provide

- Travel health visits
- Non-travel related visit for up-to-date vaccinations or tests
- Tuberculosis (TB) skin test or blood test
- Blood testing for immunity to vaccine-preventable diseases such as hepatitis B
- Vaccinations to prevent rabies after animal bites or scratches
- International immunization card or yellow fever certificate reissuance
- Yellow fever vaccination waivers
- Vaccination form completion for work or school
