Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Article 3 of the Health Code is hereby amended by revising Section 128, to read as follows:

SEC. 128. PATIENT RATES.

(a) The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby determine and fix the proper reasonable amounts to be charged to persons for services furnished by the Department of Public Health ("Department") as follows, which rates shall be effective for services delivered as of July 1, 202~~6~~⁵, through June 30, 202~~8~~⁷. The County Clerk's Office may charge the amounts listed herein for services rendered relating to vital records.

1 the official title of the ordinance.

3 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on the 31st day after
4 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
5 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
6 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
