

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - California Natural Resources Agency - ADA Work at
2 Charity Cultural Services Center - \$50,000]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of Economic and Workforce**
4 **Development to accept and expend a grant award in the amount of \$50,000 from the**
5 **State of California, California Natural Resources Agency for Americans with Disabilities**
6 **Act (ADA) restroom improvements at the Charity Cultural Services Center during the**
7 **fiscal year of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.**

9 WHEREAS, The California Legislature and Governor of the State of California have
10 approved a grant to improve disability access under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
11 to restrooms at the Charity Cultural Services Center (CCSC) in San Francisco (Grant Project);
12 and

13 WHEREAS, The State of California, through the California Natural Resources Agency
14 (CNRA) amended the California Budget Act of 2025 to appropriate \$50,000 towards the Grant
15 Project for Fiscal Year 2025-2026; and

16 WHEREAS, The CNRA has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of
17 the Grant Project, setting up necessary procedures for acceptance of the grant funds; and

18 WHEREAS, Said procedures require the City to certify by Resolution of the Board of
19 Supervisors the approval of a Project Information Package before submission of said package
20 to the State, the acceptance of the grant, and other specific terms; the Project Information
21 Package including the Project Information Form is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
22 Supervisors in File No. 260402; and

23 WHEREAS, The CNRA will provide the City an agreement with the State of California
24 for the Grant Project after the Board of Supervisors has authorized the City to accept the
25 funds; and

1 WHEREAS, The Office of Economic and Workforce Development has an existing grant
2 agreement with the CCSC that aligns in scope with the intended purposes of the Grant
3 Project; the existing grant is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File
4 No. 260402; and

5 WHEREAS, Such existing agreement with CCSC can be amended to include the grant
6 funds from CNRA for the Grant Project; and

7 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,
8 therefore, be it

9 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendments; and

10 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of Economic
11 and Workforce Development to retroactively accept and expend, on behalf of the City and
12 County of San Francisco, a \$50,000 California state general fund allocation for local
13 assistance for the Grant Project; and, be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
15 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that the City
17 understands the assurances and certification in the Project Information Form and approves
18 the Project Information Package; and, be it

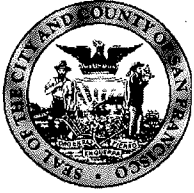
19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that CCSC, via its
20 agreement with the City will have sufficient funds to develop, operate and maintain the Grant
21 Project consistent with any land tenure requirements imposed by CNRA, or will secure the
22 resources to do so; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that the City will
24 comply with the provisions of Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors, if applicable, certifies the Grant
2 Project will comply with any laws and regulation including, but not limited to, the California
3 Environmental Quality Act, legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes,
4 disabled access laws, environmental laws and, that prior to commencement of construction,
5 all applicable licenses and permits will have been obtained; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors appoints the Director of the
7 Office of Economic Workforce and Development as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute
8 and submit all documents including, but not limited to the Project Information Form,
9 agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the
10 aforementioned Grant Project.
