12 WHEREAS, In each year, the Board of Supervisors shall designate the
13 outreach newspaper for each outreach community, pursuant to Section 2.81-3 of the
14 Administrative Code; and

15 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors may designate neighborhood
16 outreach newspaper, pursuant to Section 2.81-4 of the Administrative Code; now, therefore,
17 be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Board designates the following newspapers, which circulate
19 primarily in the indicated communities and are printed in San Francisco, to be the
20 outreach newspapers for the indicated communities for Fiscal Year (FY) 2026-2027:

21 Bay Area Reporter - Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender
22 Wind Newspaper - Chinese; and, be it

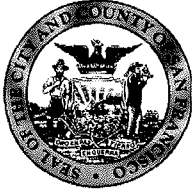




