

1 [Accept and Expend Grant Amendment - Retroactive - Board of State and Community
2 Corrections - Organized Retail Theft Prevention Grant Program - \$15,326,301]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Police Department to execute an amendment**
4 **to the grant agreement with the Board of State and Community Corrections for the**
5 **Organized Retail Theft Prevention Grant Program, extending the grant term from**
6 **June 1, 2027, for a new grant term of October 1, 2023, through June 1, 2028, with no**
7 **change to the grant amount of \$15,326,301.**

9 WHEREAS, On January 9, 2024, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance
10 No. 001-24, retroactively authorizing the Police Department to accept and expend a grant in
11 the amount of \$15,326,301 from the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) for
12 the Organized Retail Theft Prevention Grant Program for the period of October 1, 2023,
13 through June 1, 2027; and

14 WHEREAS, The original BSCC Organized Retail Theft Prevention Grant Agreement
15 provided for a grant term of October 1, 2023, through June 1, 2027, and a grant amount of
16 \$15,326,301; and

17 WHEREAS, The BSCC and the Police Department have entered into Amendment
18 No. 1 to that Grant Agreement, which extends the agreement term through June 1, 2028, with
19 no change to the grant amount of \$15,326,301; and

20 WHEREAS, Under Amendment No. 1, all project expenses must be incurred by
21 December 31, 2027, and the additional period through June 1, 2028, allows for completion of
22 required reporting and other closeout activities; and

23 WHEREAS, The BSCC requires approval by the Board of Supervisors for amendments
24 to the grant agreement; and

1 WHEREAS, The proposed amendment does not increase the grant amount previously
2 approved by the Board of Supervisors nor expand the scope of authorized expenditures, but
3 instead extends the agreement term to allow for full expenditure of remaining grant funds and
4 completion of required grant activities; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby retroactively authorizes the Chief of
6 Police to execute Amendment No. 1 to the grant agreement with the BSCC for the Organized
7 Retail Theft Prevention Grant Program, extending the grant term from June 1, 2027, to
8 June 1, 2028, with no change to the grant amount of \$15,326,301; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Police
10 Department to continue to comply with the terms and conditions of the amended grant
11 agreement as set forth by the BSCC; and, be it

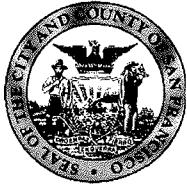
12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Chief of Police,
13 or his designee, to execute future no-cost extensions and amendments to the grant
14 agreement; and, be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the amendment being fully executed,
16 the Police Department shall provide a copy of the final amended grant agreement to the Clerk
17 of the Board of Supervisors for inclusion in the official file.

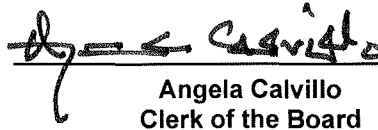

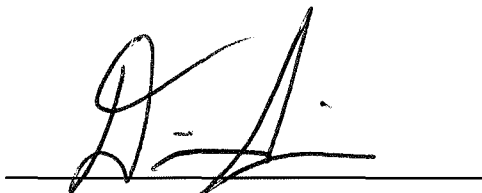
