Complaint filed by Anonymous against Harlan Kelly and the Public Utilities Commission for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Sections 67.21 failing to respond to a records request in a timely and/or complete manner; 67.26 withholding kept to a minimum and 67.27 failing to provide justification for withholding responsive documents; 67.29-7(a) failing to maintain correspondence and records in a professional and businesslike manner.

HEARING AND ACTION ON THE COMPLAINT

On July 19, 2022, the Complaint Committee acting in its capacity to hear petitions/complaints heard the matter.

In addition, the SOTF orders the Public Utilities Commission to produce any and all attachments to the emails and text records that were sought in the Petitioner's (Anonymous') request.
